1 On page 13, strike lines 1 through 14 and insert the
2 following:

3 “(ii) Section 111, relating to assault-
4 ing, resisting, or impeding certain officers
5 or employees.

6 “(iii) Section 113(a), relating to as-
7 saults within maritime and territorial juris-
8 diction.

9 On page 15, line 14, strike “section 1112” and all
10 that follows through “manslaughter),” on line 18.

1 On page 16, line 3, strike “persons,” and all that fol-
2 lows through the end of line 4 and insert “persons.”.

3 On page 16, strike line 20 and all that follows
4 through page 17, line 7, and insert the following:

5 “(xxvii) Subsection (a), (d), or (e) of
6 section 2113, relating to certain bank rob-
7 beries and incidental crimes.

8 “(xxviii) Subsection (a) or (c) of sec-
9 tion 2118, relating to certain robberies and
10 burglaries involving controlled substances.

11 “(xxix) Section 2119, relating to tak-
12 ing a motor vehicle (commonly referred to
13 as ‘carjacking’).

14 On page 20, strike line 19 and all that follows
15 through page 21, line 2, and insert the following:

16 “(lii) Section 401 of the Controlled
17 Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 841), relating
18 to manufacturing or distributing a con-
19 trolled substance.

20 On page 24, line 1, strike “(lii)” and insert “(lxii)”.

21 On page 24, after line 24, add the following:

1 “(lxiii) Any offense under Federal law
2 that is a crime of violence, as defined in
3 section 16.

4 “(lxiv) Any offense under Federal law
5 that is a sex offense, as defined in section
6 111 of the Adam Walsh Child Protection
7 and Safety Act of 2006 (34 U.S.C.
8 20911).

9 “(lxv) Section 36, relating to drive-by-
10 shootings.

11 “(lxvi) Section 114, relating to maim-
12 ing within maritime and territorial juris-
13 diction.

14 “(lxvii) Section 249, relating to hate
15 crimes.

16 “(lxviii) Section 2101, relating to
17 riots.

18 “(lxix) Section 2111, relating to rob-
19 bery within the special maritime and terri-
20 torial jurisdiction of the United States.

21 “(lxx) Section 2261, relating to inter-
22 state domestic violence.

23 “(lxxi) Section 2261A, relating to
24 stalking.

1 “(lxxii) Section 2421, relating to
2 transportation for illegal sexual activity.

3 “(lxxiii) Section 2422, relating to co-
4 ercion and enticement relating to transpor-
5 tation for illegal sexual activity.

6 “(lxxiv) Section 2423, relating to
7 transportation of minors for illegal sexual
8 activity.

9 “(lxxv) Section 2425, relating to the
10 use of interstate facilities to transmit in-
11 formation about a minor relating to illegal
12 sexual activity.

13 “(lxxvi) Section 1010 or 1012 of the
14 Controlled Substances Import Export Act
15 (21 U.S.C. 960, 962), relating to import-
16 ing or exporting controlled substances.

17 “(lxxvii) Section 70506 of title 46,
18 United States Code, relating to maritime
19 drug law enforcement.

20 On page 70, strike line 2 and all that follows through
21 page 74, line 21.
