AMENDMENTS intended to be proposed by Mr. SASSE to
the amendment (No. 4108) proposed by Mr. GRASSLEY

Viz:

1 In section 3631 of title 18, United States Code, as
2 added by section 101(a) of this Act—

3 (1) in subsection (a)—

4 (A) in paragraph (4), add “and” at the
5 end;

6 (B) in paragraph (5), strike “; and” and
7 insert a period; and

8 (C) strike paragraph (6).

9 In section 3632 of title 18, United States Code, as
10 added by section 101(a) of this Act—

1 (1) in subsection (a), strike “, in consultation
2 with the Independent Review Committee authorized
3 by the First Step Act of 2018,”; and

4 (2) in subsection (d)—

5 (A) in paragraph (4)—

6 (i) in subparagraph (C), strike the pe-
7 riod at the end and insert “, except that
8 the Director of the Bureau of Prisons may
9 deny such a transfer if the warden of the
10 prison finds that the prisoner should not
11 be transferred into prerelease custody
12 based on the prisoner’s programmatic
13 needs, the prisoner’s conduct or actions
14 after the conviction of such prisoner, the
15 prisoner’s risk of recidivism, the avail-
16 ability of the Bureau of Prisons’ resources
17 to ensure adequate supervision of the pris-
18 oner while in prerelease custody, and other
19 conditions that the Director of the Bureau
20 of Prisons determines are appropriate for
21 public safety or recidivism reduction pur-
22 poses. The determination of whether the
23 prisoner should be transferred into
24 prerelease custody or supervised release

1 under this paragraph shall not be review-
2 able by any court.”; and

3 (ii) in strike subparagraph (E)(i) and
4 insert the following:

5 “(i) IN GENERAL.—A prisoner is ineli-
6 gible to apply time credits under subpara-
7 graph (C) if the prisoner is—

8 “(I) the subject to an immigra-
9 tion detainer or to a final order of re-
10 moval under any provision of the im-
11 migration laws (as such term is de-
12 fined in section 101(a)(17) of the Im-
13 migration and Nationality Act (8
14 U.S.C. 1101(a)(17))); or

15 “(II) is found by the Director of
16 the Bureau of Prisons to be likely to
17 be a deportable alien described in sec-
18 tion 237(a) of the Immigration and
19 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)).”;
20 and

21 (B) in paragraph (6), insert “, except no
22 activity that earns a prisoner credit for any
23 other incentive or reward shall earn the pris-
24 oner any incentives under this subsection” be-
25 fore the period at the end.

1 In section 3633(a) of title 18, United States Code,
2 as added by section 101(a) of this Act, strike “, in con-
3 sultation with the Independent Review Committee author-
4 ized by the First Step Act of 2018,”.

5 In section 3635 of title 18, United States Code, as
6 added by section 101(a) of this Act—

7 (1) in paragraph (3)—

8 (A) in subparagraph (B), strike “and” at
9 the end;

10 (B) in subparagraph (C)(xiii), strike the
11 period at the end and insert “; and”; and

12 (C) add at the end the following:

13 “(D) may not include any training that
14 would enhance the capacity of the prisoner to
15 commit any crime similar to those for which the
16 prisoner is incarcerated.”;

17 (2) strike paragraph (5);

18 (3) redesignate paragraph (6) as paragraph (5).

19 In section 3624(g) of title 18, United States Code,
20 as added by section 102(b) of this Act—

21 (1) strike paragraph (1)(D) and insert the fol-
22 lowing:

1 apprenticeship, or participate in
2 job-seeking activities;

3 “(bb) participate in evi-
4 dence-based recidivism reduction
5 programming or productive ac-
6 tivities assigned by the System,
7 or similar activities;

8 “(cc) perform community
9 service;

10 “(dd) participate in crime
11 victim restoration activities;

12 “(ee) receive medical treat-
13 ment;

14 “(ff) attend religious activi-
15 ties; or

16 “(gg) participate in other
17 family-related activities that fa-
18 cilitate the prisoner’s successful
19 reentry such as a family funeral,
20 a family wedding, or to visit a
21 family member who is seriously
22 ill; and

23 “(III) comply with such other
24 conditions as the Director determines
25 appropriate.

1 “(ii) DURATION.—Except as provided
2 in paragraph (4), a prisoner who is placed
3 in home confinement shall remain in home
4 confinement until the prisoner has served
5 not less than 85 percent of the prisoner’s
6 imposed term of imprisonment.”.
